DEFINITIONS AND AGE GROUPS

TEACHER STUDENT DEFINITION AND AGE GROUP

Events are for Amateur dancers partnered by a teacher either Professional or Amateur

- Teachers who dance in Teacher Student competitions must be registered by the BDC or their own Organisation /School
- The term Teacher/Student refers to a Professional/Amateur Teacher dancing with their Student.
- Teacher/Student couples must comprise of a Teacher dancing with a Student dancer who does not teach Ballroom, Latin, American Smooth or American Rhythm.
- Teacher/Student competitors may only have one partner in each event. No split partnerships.
- If both competitors are dancing in any other Blackpool Dance Festival Amateur or Professional events together from 23rd to 31st May, they cannot compete in the Teacher Student section as a couple.

Age Groups

OPEN - Z1 - 16- 25 Z2 - 26 -40 Y1 - 41-50 Y2 - 51-65 X1 - 66+ <u>CLOSED - Z1 - 16 -34 Z2 - 35 -49 Y1 - 50</u>-64 Y2 - 65+

PROAM DEFINITION AND AGE GROUP

Events are for Amateur Dancers being partnered by a Professional Dancer.

ProAm competitions will not offer any level divisions.

To be eligible to enter you must be of beginner level and above.

- a. The term "ProAm" refers to a Professional Dancer/Teacher dancing with their student.In this case the student will be known as a ProAm Student Dancer. A ProAm Student Dancer competes with a Professional Dancer.
- b. A ProAm Student dancer does not teach Ballroom/Latin/American Smooth/American Rhythm. Professional competitors may only have one partner in each event. No split <u>partnerships.</u>

Age Groups

OPEN - A1 16-30 A2 31-40 A3 41-50 B1 51-60 B2 61-70 C 71+ D 76+ (female only) E 80+ (female only CLOSED - A1 - 16 - 34 A2 - 35 - 49 A3 - 50-64 B1 - 65+

The age group is devised by the age of the Amateur/Student Dancer. Proof of age may be requested. The ProAm Student Dancer may also dance two age divisions directly younger; for example B1 may also dance A2 if they wish. Maximum of two age groups can be entered.

Female Dancers to enter the correct Female Category and may compete in either role.

Male Dancers to enter the correct Male Category and may compete in either role

Two people of the same gender may compete without fear or favour.
